

Edinburgh People's Festival Arts Competition Rules 2009
'Let The People Speak'

1. Competition and exhibition are open to all artists over the age of 18 living or working in Scotland.
2. Artists involved in the organisation of 'Let The People Speak' are eligible to apply for the exhibition but not take part in the competition.
3. Artists may submit up to 3 works that must have been completed since 1 January 2008.
4. All works must be suitable for wall mounting. Size of work, including frames must not exceed 180x150cm (6ftx5ft).
5. Where possible all works must be mirror plated and to be attached to the reverse of the art work.
6. All entered artwork should have some connection to the theme – 'Let The People Speak'.
7. A selection committee of: Mark L'Anson, Artist
Lisa Arnott, Community Artist
will select works for the exhibition. The entries will be independently judged by Richard Demarco. There will also be a 'People's Prize' for the most popular entry as decided by visitors to the exhibition.
8. All works to be handed into North Edinburgh Arts Centre, 15a Pennywell Court, Muirhouse, Edinburgh, EH4 4TZ on Tuesday 28 July between the hours of 11am and 5pm. No entries will be accepted after this.
9. All works must be clearly labelled WITH artist's name, address, title of work, medium and price (including commission) on the back of the artwork.
10. In addition an Edinburgh Peoples Festival label must be filled out and attached, by string, to the work.
11. There is no registration fee. A commission of 20% will be levied on all sales. NOTE: The price of the work on the entry form and label must include the 20% commission. Works not for sale should be labelled N.F.S.
12. Once in the North Edinburgh Arts Centre under the terms of their insurance all artworks of the value £500 and above will be insured. All artworks with an 'on the wall' value below £500 will not be insured.
13. All artists submitting work will be notified if their work is selected by email (unless specifically requested otherwise) by 31 July 2009.
14. All artist submitting works are invited to the opening exhibition on Wednesday 5th August 2009 6.30pm – 8pm.
15. Collection of work both selected and unselected work will be from the North Edinburgh Arts Centre, 15A Pennywell Court, Edinburgh, EH4 4TZ on Monday 31 August between 3 - 5pm.
16. The decision of the selectors and judges is final and no correspondence about their decisions will be entered into.
17. Copyright of all work entered for the 'Let The People Speak' will remain the property of the artist. However it is condition of entry that exhibited works may be photographed for press and promotional purposes.
18. The Edinburgh People's Festival will hold personal data supplied on your registration form securely, in accordance with Data Protection Act, 1998. It will only be used for administering the exhibition/ competition and will not be transferred to any other party.
